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Agenda items discussed at the meeting.

1. Antennae at Hanimadhoo and Kadhdhoo.

- The participants strongly urged that a Regional Airports representative be present at the meeting as issues pertinent to Regional Airports are mainly in the agenda.
- It was discussed that if CAD gives permission, CAD should monitor and inspect the progress of the work permitted.
- It was informed that the issue of antenna had been raised and CAD is in the process of inspecting the airports of Hanimaadhoo and Kadhdhoo

2. Emergency plans at domestic airports.

- Drafting of the emergency plan for the Regional Airport Kadhdhoo had been completed and submitted to Airports Company.
- The meeting was informed that the draft emergency plans for other regional airports will to be completed by 1st November 2005
- The Maldives Airports Company representative agreed to inform the progress of the drafting of the Emergency plans to the meeting regularly.



3. Runway incursions.

- The Airports Company agreed to review the proper definition of Runway Incursions.
- It was agreed that the Airports Company will monitor the frequency of incursions and provide data for the next meeting.

4. Licensing of drivers at airport.

- The Maldives Airports Company is to conduct a training programme for the drivers and once all drivers are certified; only drivers certified should be allowed to drive in the airport.

5. Security at Domestic Airports.

- Members discussed the issue of breaches of security at the Regional Airports.
- The meeting was informed that CAD was taking actions to review the incident of such nature at the Regional Airports.
- The committee suggested that the safety issues be mandated by the DGCA for this committee to discuss these issues of security.

6. Any other business.

- It was agreed to invite Ibrahim Khalid to the safety meetings for a period of time as most of the issues in the agenda are AIS issues.
- All participants present urged the members of the committee to attend the meetings regularly.
- It was agreed that the water tanks at the end of the water runway at Hulumale to inspect by CAD and reported to the next meeting.
