3. Runway incursions.

- It was suggested to conduct a survey to check how frequent a runway incursion occurs within the next 30 days.
- It was discussed to produce a procedure to standardize crossing of the runway by traffic.

4. Licensing of drivers present at airport.

- It was discussed to write to Transport ministry's licensing section regarding the licensing of drivers on airports by the Civil Aviation Department. However this was not agreed upon.
- It was discussed to educate the drivers regarding the safety awareness.
