Agenda items discussed at the meeting

1. TCAS Incident

- It was agreed to advice ATC to make a procedure to separate traffic in a way that TCAS alerts are not activated
- It was agreed that all operators and ATC to report all TCAS incidents to CAD. This is to maintain as per the present reporting system.

2. Flight Documentation System

- All members were asked to establish a flight documentation system, if they have not done so until now and also that the Advisory circular regarding this matter will be mailed to all MAST members.

3. Antennae at Hanimadhoo and Kadhdhoo.

- It was agreed to check the possibilities for a reclassification of mentioned airports. As this may have an additional impact on limitation reference to the present antennae problems. Also we agreed to request to make required amendments to AIP including approach plates as soon as possible.



4. Emergency plans at domestic airports.

- The Maldives Airports Company representative informed about the progress of all emergency plans and that this has been sent to CAD and the all the members of MAST.

5. Runway incursions.

- CAD informed the members that the incident Q23413 as not a runway incursion.
- The Maldives Airports Company representative informed that there had been no runway incursions so far and agreed to send a report on it before the next meeting.
- All the members agreed to read the documents from the SARAST meeting (distributed in CD's) and also to comment about it on the next safety meeting

6. Licensing of drivers at airport.

- No updates received from the Maldives Airports Company.

7. Security at Domestic Airports.

- No updates received from the Regional Airports.

8. Water Runway

- A meeting to be held at the Maldives Airports Company next week to discuss the issue of water runways, all the Operators and Civil Aviation Department are invited.

9. Safety Equipments on the Floating Platforms.

- The Operators are to submit the case of safety equipments on floating platforms to CAD.
